Select/Junior A Fees are payable by separate cheque before first tryout. Cheques will be held in trust until player selection. Only successful player's cheques will be cashed. All others will be destroyed.

Equipment supplied by the Association shall be returned in good condition at season end. If not returned or returned in poor condition it is the financial responsibility of the parents/guardian and will be replaced at Association cost price.

Registration Process: Please make cheques payable to DARTMOUTH BANDITS LACROSSE and include your completed and signed registration form, liability waiver and Code of Conduct, the \$50 jersey deposit (a separate one for each player) and registration fees. If trying out for Select/Junior A, please include a separate cheque. Mail all requirements to the address at the top of this page or bring to one of the Open Registration Days (dates at top of page one).

Registration Fees For 2009 include Winter School Program and early-season practice times.

Refund Policy: All fees must be paid before a player will be permitted to practice or play. Refund of registration fees will not be considered after March 30th except for valid medical reasons, up to and including the 4th game of the season, in which case a pro-rated refund will apply. A medical certificate will be required. A \$50 administration fee is applied to all refunds.

Privacy Statement: Dartmouth Bandits Lacrosse Association respects your privacy. We protect your personal information and only share it with the directors, officers, coaches and officials of the Dartmouth Bandits Lacrosse Assoc., and our governing agents (Canadian Lacrosse Association/Lacrosse Nova Scotia/Metro Minor Lacrosse League) as required.

Team Placement: Space is not guaranteed and spots are filled on a first come, first served basis. Registration is only considered valid after all registration requirements are fulfilled. Select and Junior A team spots are awarded after a try out evaluation and subject to additional fees.

Family Discounts: First player pays regular price, additional players each receive a \$25 discount. This does not apply if one of the players is a Goalie or a Masters player.

Jersey Deposit: A \$50 cheque postdated to October 15, 2009 must accompany each registration to be held in security until the jersey is returned.

PARENTAL CODE OF CONDUCT.

1. I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning, so that he/she will not feel defeated at the outcome of a game.
 2. I will encourage my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
 3. I will praise my child for trying hard and competing fairly, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
 4. I will never ridicule or yell at my child, other players, coaches or officials. I will cheer all good plays and avoid booing opponents.
 5. I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteer coaches and officials who give their time to my child.
 6. I will remember that the players are amateurs that cannot be judged by the standard of a professional lacrosse team.
 7. I understand that all officials do their utmost to be impartial to provide a safe and suitable framework that the game is well played and I will respect their decisions.
 8. I will not question the officials' bias or judgment in public.
 9. I will show respect for my team's opponents, because without them there would be no game.
 10. I will not use profanity, nor will I harass players, coaches, officials, or other spectators.
 11. I will remember that my child plays lacrosse for his/her enjoyment and not mine.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT.

1. I will follow the rules of FAIR PLAY: I will respect the rules of the game, I will respect my opponents, I will respect the officials and their decisions, everyone will participate, and I will maintain my self-control at all times.
 2. On game day, all players shall be in the dressing room at least 30 minutes prior to game time. Players shall be fully dressed and ready to go at least 15 minutes prior to game time. This period will be necessary to discuss team strategies and game plans. If you require more time to dress, come earlier.
 3. On practice day, players shall be in the dressing room at least 20 minutes prior to practice time.
 4. Players shall participate in every game and every practice except for illness, injury, or school events. If a player must miss a game or practice, he/she must contact the team manager or coach as soon as possible.
 5. School shall take precedence over Lacrosse.
 6. Foul language towards teammates, coaches, officials, or opponents will not be tolerated.
 7. Players shall not be critical of teammates and never discuss teammates abilities except to encourage good team play.
 8. Hot-dogging will not be tolerated.
 9. Players are responsible for their own equipment and will ensure it is complete, safe, and in good condition at all times.
 10. Each player shall use his/her own water bottle.
 11. Lacrosse is a team sport. I am on a team and will be a team player.
 12. Winning isn't everything. Doing my best in all games and practices IS everything.
 13. I will respect all my teammates and my competitors.
 14. If I score a goal I will thank my line-mates for helping me score the goal. If we get scored on when I am on the floor, I will encourage my goalie and try harder to help him next time.
 15. I will listen to my coaches' instructions.
 16. Each Player represents the game of lacrosse, the lacrosse association, and their team. Players shall conduct themselves in a dignified manner at all times, especially on 'the road'.

For Participants of the Age of Majority in Nova Scotia, you MUST read and understand this waiver prior to participating in Athletic activities. Indicate acceptance by signing the waiver where indicated.

WARNING: THIS AGREEMENT WILL AFFECT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS. READ IT CAREFULLY!

The following waiver of all claims, release from all liability, assumption of all risk and other terms of this agreement are entered into by me with and for the benefit of Dartmouth Minor Lacrosse Association, its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, coaches, officials, business operators, agents and site property owners or Occupiers (the *Organization"). Occupiers is defined in accordance with the definition of Occupiers contained in the Occupiers Liability legislation applicable to the Province or Territory in which the Athletic Activities are provided by the Organization. Canadian Lacrosse Association/Lacrosse Nova Scotia, Metro Minor Lacrosse league are the governing agents of the organization and are responsible for the enforcement of the rules of play, discipline conduct certification and administrative policies.

1. I am executing this waiver with the intent that this waiver be binding on myself for all legal purposes.
- 2 "Athletic Activities" includes but is not limited to contact and non-contact sports, fitness activities, personal training instruction and activities, use of facilities, and fitness programs and services provided to the player by the Organization.
3. I am aware that there are inherent and significant risks ("Risks") associated with the participation in Athletic Activities. I am aware that those Risks include but are not limited to the potential for serious personal injury caused by any event or any condition of the facility or equipment where Athletic Activities are provided by the Organization, and health risks such as transient light-headedness, fainting abnormal blood pressure, chest discomfort muscle cramps or soreness, and nausea I understand the Risks are relative to my state of fitness and health (physical, mental and emotional), and to the awareness, care and skill with which I conduct myself while participating in Athletic Activities.
4. I freely accept and fully assume all responsibility for all Risk and possibilities of personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting from my participation in Athletic Activities. I agree that although the Organization has taken steps to reduce the Risks and increase safety of the Athletic Activities, it is not possible for the Organization to make the Athletic Activities completely safe. I accept those Risks and free to the terms of this waiver even if the Organization is found to be negligent or in breach of any duty of care or any obligation to me during participation in Athletic Activities.
5. I acknowledge my obligation to immediately inform the nearest employee or others of the Organization if I feel any pain, discomfort, fatigue, or other symptoms that I may suffer during and immediately after participation in Athletic Activities. I understand that I may stop participation at any time, and that I may be requested to stop by an employee or others of the Organization who observes any symptoms of distress or abnormal response.
6. In addition to consideration given to the Organization for my participation in Athletic Activities, I and my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators and assigns, (collectively our

"Legal Representatives"), agree:

a- to waive all claims that I have or may have in the future against the Organization;

b, to release and forever discharge the Organization from all liability for all personal injury, death, property damage, or loss resulting from my participation in the Fitness Activities due to any cause, including but not limited to negligence (failure to use such care as a reasonably prudent and careful person would use under similar circumstances), breach of any duty imposed by law, breach of contract or mistake or error of judgment of the Organizations; and

c. to be liable for and to hold harmless and indemnify the Organization from all actions, proceedings, claim, damages, costs demands including court costs and costs on a solicitor and own client basis, and liabilities of whatsoever nature of any kind arising out of or in any way connected with my participation in Athletic Activities.

7. I agree that this waiver and all terms contained within are governed exclusively by the laws of the Province or Territory of Canada in which the Athletic Activities are provided to me by the Organization. I hereby irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of that Province or Territory. Any litigation to enforce this waiver must be instituted in the Province or Territory in which the Athletic Activities are provided by the Organization.

8. I confirm that I have had sufficient time to read and understand each term of this waiver in its entirety, and have agreed to the terms freely and voluntarily. I understand that this waiver is binding on my Legal representatives and myself.
